



GWP-Award Turkey 2019 for young water professionals

German Water Partnership (GWP) is a joint initiative of roundabout 350 members from the German private and public sectors, combining commercial enterprises, government and non-government organisations, scientific institutions and water-related associations. Concentrating their expertise and know-how, German Water Partnership is the single point of contact concerning the German water sector for partners from abroad.

The fundamental aim of the network is to make the outstanding German engineering, know-how and experience in the water sector easily available to partners and clients all over the world. In 15 regional sections German water experts, in close cooperation with local partners, concentrate competencies and offer a broad range of products and services in order to work on solutions, catering to the individual needs of the focus countries. One of the most important regional sections of GWP is Turkey.

In order to support further the Turkish efforts in the field of sustainable environmental protection in Turkey, highly qualified engineers and experts are needed. Considering the importance of education in this field, German Water Partnership decided to launch the "GWP-Award Turkey" for young water professionals, specialising in the issue of water and wastewater.

This year's edition will run under the topic:

"Production and use of renewable energies for wastewater treatment plants"

A jury composed of Turkish and German water experts will review the applications. The three winners will receive an award-certificate and a small financial contribution for further research work. Furthermore they will be invited to present their work at the IFAT Eurasia (28th to 30th March 2019) in Istanbul and on the 8th Turkish-German Water Partnership-Day (1st to 2nd October 2019) in Izmir.

Interested young professionals are invited to send their applications **by 28th February 2019** at the latest, following the guidelines described on the next page.



Conditions to enter the competition:

- Applicant cannot have passed the legal age of 35 years at submission date
- Applicant must declare that the information in the application is based on his/her own work and effort
- Application shall summarise results of applied research work or of practical applications in the fields of **"Production and use of renewable energies for wastewater treatment plants"**
- Submitted summaries must be written in English; applications written in other languages will not be considered
- Submitted summaries cannot exceed 6,000 characters; applications exceeding this length will not be considered
- Application cannot be password protected and must not exceed 5MB in total size
- Application must mention the title of entry as well as name, title, mailing address, email, phone number, birth date, organisation / university / research institute / company of the applicant
- Application must be sent in PDF; no other formats will be accepted

- The **application deadline is set to be on 28th February 2019**; any submission sent after the deadline will not be considered, no exceptions will be granted
- The three winners will be announced and invited to present their work at the IFAT Eurasia (28th to 30th March 2019) in Istanbul and on the 8th Turkish-German Water Partnership-Day (1st to 2nd October 2019) in Izmir
